

Robina to Varsity Lakes Rail Extension

The TrackStar Alliance is constructing the 4.1 km extension of the Gold Coast Line from Robina station to Varsity Lakes.

Construction commenced in July 2007 and the track is due to be opened late 2009.



The RTSA and Trackstar are running a tour of the works on Friday 1st May.

The tour will take around two hours.

A morning tour will be added if there is enough interest.
