## Dale Budd

After graduating from Sydney University in 1965 with a mechanical engineering degree, Dale worked in both private and public sectors as a manager and management consultant.

He has had a varied career. He was Chief-of-Staff to the then Prime Minister, Malcolm Fraser, a member of the Kimberley Water Resources Development Advisory Board, Chairman of the Board of Canberra Grammar School, chairman of the Capital Region Development Board and a member of the Board of the Australia Institute of Company Directors.

He has worked as a member of an International Union of railways team which briefed the Board of Indian railways on high speed rail.

Dale was also involved in the VFT and Speedrail proposals of high speed rail services between Sydney, Canberra and Melbourne between 1985 and 2000.

From 2001 to 2007 Dale was a member of the board of the Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC). He had particular involvement in the early development of the Advanced Train Management System (ATMS). Since 2008 he has been Chairman of the Development Advisory Board, an independent body whose role is to oversee and review the processes of development of standards for the rail industry in Australia.

Dale is currently the project manager of the Melbourne-Brisbane Inland Rail Alignment Study for the ARTC.
