The Wheel-Rail Interface Award will be awarded by the Railway Technical Society of Australasia (RTSA) to the author of an outstanding final year undergraduate thesis or a post graduate thesis on a topic related to the contact conditions between wheel and rail and the consequences of these conditions in terms of material behaviour and damage modes.

The work reported in the thesis shall have been undertaken in Australia or New Zealand by an author of a final year undergraduate thesis or post graduate thesis completed during either 2009 or 2010.

PRIZE CONSISTS OF:

- > \$4000 cash prize
- > Plaque
- > One-year free RTSA membership

At its discretion the Awards Sub-Committee may award up to two 'runner up' prizes each of \$2000 together with one-year free RTSA membership.
